Red Techniques Vary Day To Day

J. Edgar Hoover, director of the FBI since 1924, emphasizes that the danger to the United States from master Red plotters is as great as ever. In this week's installment of his book "Masters of Deceit," Hoover tells how U.S. Communists plot and plan to establish a Soviet America.

INSTALLMENT THIRTEEN

Unquestionably, the ultimate aim of the Communist Party is the establishment of a Soviet America. Never for a moment in more than a generation have Communists in the United States forgotten their allegiance to the Soviet Union.

The Communist Party, USA, is a weapon of attack, at work now. To Party leaders each day is a day of preparation and dress rehearsal for the day when they hope to come to power.

Each day there are objectives: non-Communist ranks must be infiltrated and subverted. The success of the world communist mission depends on capturing the enemy's stronghold from within.

To this end, as indicated in previous installments of this account, the Party employs a variety of mass-agitation techniques. The communist is in the market places of America: in organizations, on street corners, even at your front door. He is trying to influence and control your thoughts. Mass agitation weakens the non-Communist enemy and builds Party structure.

PARTY LEADERS realize that communists are a minority who cannot march straight to victory. The approach (tactics) must be varied, flexible, and constantly subject to change.

To communists, strategy means the determining and carrying out of long-range goals (such as winning a war), whereas tactics are the working out of strategy on a day-to-day basis (winning particular battles and engagements). "Tactics," Stalin said, "are a part of strategy, subordinate and subservient to it."

Lenin Advises

'Zig-zags'

To achieve the long-range goal, retreats and maneuvers sometimes are necessary. Is it not like climbing an unexplored mountain? Lenin asked. How can we renounce beforehand the ideas that at times we might have to renege on, some times retreating our steps, sometimes abandoning the course selected and trying various others?" he said.

That explains the communist phrase, "strategic retreat." It means: Don't be afraid to take two steps backward today if it will help to achieve three steps forward tomorrow. Keep the goal always in mind, teach the communists to remember that the enemy is superior in numbers, better armed, more experienced. Communists must be willing to endure hardships.

Lenin urged: "... if you are not inclined to crawl in the mud on your belly, you are not a revolutionary but a chatter-box."

Fight hard and be disciplined, carefully, attentively and skillfully.

crisis." Actually, communists want an economic crisis to develop.

THEY ADVOCATE unrestricted trade between the United States and Russia because Russia would benefit. Thus the communist periodical "Political Affairs" urges, "The only untapped market for U.S. goods is the Soviet Union, China and the Peoples Democracies, in which the threat of crises of overproduction has been removed forever..."

Special Line For Each Group

In seeking to curry favor with union labor, communists employ tactics incorporating demands for higher wages, a shorter work week, increased vacations, and controls on living costs. To that end a communist labor union tactician calls for putting "... ideological differences aside in order to work together in behalf of a single immediate objective or a number of immediate objectives... the unions must work together..."

Tactics are also employed by the communists to find favor with Negroes. The controversy on integration has given the United States communists a field day.

Communists have a program "... to stimulate broad united-front actions in the rural communities in defense of the economic interests of the farming masses"; to weld youth unity; and to "work still harder" for rights of mothers.

A primary tactic of the Communist Party is to preserve the legal status of the Party. Thus, any organization which has the duty to investigate or expose communist activity is singled out for attack.

For years the Party has campaigned against the House Committee on Un-American Activities, the Senate Internal Security Subcommittee, and the Senate Investigating Committee. The Department of Justice and the FBI have not been spared, and we have come to judge our effectiveness by the intensity of communist attacks.

The Red Fascists have long followed the practice of making full use of democratic liberties—elections, lawful agitation and propaganda, and free speech, press, and assembly.

At the same time, they do not hesitate to use illegal methods, such as underground operations, terrorism, espionage, sabotage, lying, cheating.

"We have never rejected terror on principle, nor can we do so. Terror is a form of military operation that may be usefully applied..." Lenin advised. "Morally it is regarded as strictly a bourgeois device. To the communists everything that promotes the revolution is moral, legal, and beautiful."

Americans Often Duped By Reds

MANY PERSONS in the United States have been confused by the Party's abrupt twists and turns, such as denouncing the United States as an "imperialist" nation from 1939 to 1941, then overnight, after Russia's entrance into the war, hailing America as a great ally. These "changes-in-the-Party line" are merely shifting tactics in the overall design to promote the ultimate goal of world revolution. They are not changes in heart.

The Communist Party, U.S.A., has been and is engaged in an all-out war against American freedom. Its tactics of confusion, retreat, advance, infiltration, and hypocrisy are in full play today. The attack is both legal and illegal, offensive and defensive, open and concealed.

Former Monastery Houses Handicapped Youngsters

The former Carmelite monastery at 1530 East Avenue will be occupied by the Day Care Center for Handicapped Children on or about September 1, according to an announcement from James P. Duffy, chairman of the board of the Day Care Center.

The Day Care Center was founded in 1949 and since that time has had to borrow space and facilities to conduct its program. At present, its 50 pupils are housed in School 17 and at the Lake Avenue Baptist Church.

Mr. Duffy explained that the former monastery could hold as many as 150 children. The rate of expansion will depend, he said, on the money available to engage the teaching staff and buy more facilities. The Center now has a waiting list of 70 youngsters.

Authorities Sceptical

Children Report Vision Of Our Lady

Terni, Italy. — (NC) — Church authorities here have found no basis for belief in the reported appearance of Our Lady to two children in a nearby village.

About two weeks ago two children of the village of Latteria di Maratta, 40 miles north of Rome, said they had seen the Blessed Virgin in the barnyard of an isolated farmhouse.

They also said that Our Lady had promised to perform a miracle at nine o'clock on the night of July 3 which would bring about the cure of an 11-month-old baby girl born with encephalitis, an inflammation of the brain.

THEY SKEPTICAL attitude of the local clergy in no way militated the impression made on the people of the village and the surrounding area. The nine-year-old girl, Paola Piazza, and 11-year-old boy, Gino Armadori, went every night to the barnyard to pray, accompanied by a growing number of people.

Each night the children claimed they had seen the Blessed Virgin, and that she had repeated her promise.

On the night of July 3 an estimated 30,000 people were present to see whether the promised miracle would occur. Nine o'clock passed and the baby girl was not cured, but many people claimed that at midnight they had seen a trail of light from the moon to a mound of flowers that had been placed where Our Lady was

alleged to have appeared to the children.

Investigations later proved that at that precise time a jet airplane was traveling in the same direction as the reported trail of light.

Terni diocesan officials have made some inquiries and have reported that there is no evidence of anything supernatural. Nevertheless crowds continue to gather nightly.

The two children promised another miracle for July 10, without specifying its nature. They said they have nothing further to promise about the cure of the infant which failed to occur. It has been reported that the children have been questioned and found to be in good faith.

Apparitions Reported, Caution Urged

Madrid. — (NC) — Church authorities here have recommended the utmost reserve in regard to alleged apparitions of the Blessed Virgin to a group of children from the village of Jorcas in the province of Teruel in eastern Spain.

Scattered reports concerning the alleged visions have appeared in the Catholic press. They give the following account of the events alleged to have occurred:

EIGHTEEN CHILDREN of the village of Jorcas claim to have had a series of apparitions of the Blessed Virgin, beginning this year on June 6, the day after the feast of Corpus Christi, and

ending on June 20. Seven of the eight children made their First Communion on Corpus Christi. They range in age from 7 to 15.

The apparitions are said to have occurred near the village in a cave known as the grotto of St. Joseph. The descriptions of the Virgin given by the children agree in details: she appears kneeling, dressed in white and blue, and displaying a luminous heart.

The apparitions reportedly took place daily from June 6 to June 12, with a final one on June 20 to four of the children, one of

them a deaf mute. Afterwards, the deaf child was given paper to sketch what he had seen. The drawing agreed with the description of the Virgin given by the other children.

JOSE ORTEGA, the village schoolmaster, who questioned the children, said they accounts of what took place coincide. He said the children have never left the village and have not seen motion pictures dealing with the apparitions at Lourdes and Fatima.

Jorcas is a town of 333 inhabitants located in the Psoy mountain range.
