Father Scheier Named A Fellow

St. Bonaventure, N. Y.—Rev. Maurice Scheier, OFM, long-time member of the St. Bonaventure University faculty, has been elected a fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science.

Father Scheier has been a professor of mathematics at the university since joining the faculty in 1928. In addition, he headed the department from 1933 until 1932 when he was elected regius superior of the St. Bonaventure Friary.
