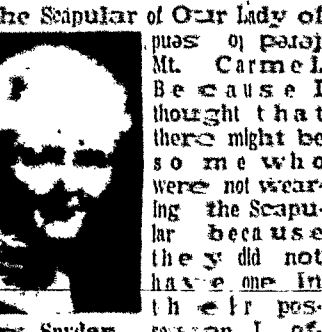

AMONG WOMEN 'Forgotten' Scapular

About a year ago this week I wrote an article for this column on the Scapular of Our Lady of Mount Carmel. Because I thought that there might be some who were not wearing the Scapular because they did not have one in their possession, I of-

As I wrote in subsequent columns, the response was amazing. After the heavy demand tapered off, the requests continued to trickle in for months.

I was particularly interested in the letters I received. Several wrote that they had almost "forgotten" about the Scapular since they had left school.

THIS ADMITTED forgetting on the part of Catholics sufficiently interested in their religion to read the diocesan newspaper prompts me to write again on this same subject.

Since the opening of Mt. Carmel High School, our own community, I have been interested to observe how many of our high school boys and girls are wearing scapulars. I have noticed that the boys seem to be particularly devoted to the Scapular.

They knot the Scapular close to their necks in the back and front; and while frequent dives into Onwase Lake do not improve the appearance of the Scapular, it stays securely on the wearer and satisfies regulations regarding its wearing.

I have discovered that Scapulars on sterling silver chains (if they are properly made to observe the ruling that the chain must be attached to the cloth) are easier for me to wear in the summer months.

Of course, I realize that if one wears the Scapular, the habit of Our Lady, one should be willing to accept the penitential aspects of such an honor but living in the world, one must also consider practical points of hygiene and appearance. Thus the chains are most acceptable in hot weather.
