Durban, South Africa.—(NC)—Do you think you could support a family of five on \$42 a month?

That's the question Archbishop Denis E. Hurley, O.M.I., of Durban propounded recently to the Durban city governing body.

He allocated \$16.80 for rent, fuel, soap, transportation and clothing. The remaining \$25.20 is for food and this breaks down to 84 cents a day for the whole family.

Jowitz, a cousin of the late Lord Jowitz, one-time British Lord Chancellor, who spent 45 years in Africa, where he held important educational posts in Kenya, Bechuanaland, Basutoland and Southern Rhodesia. He was also for seven years a member of the Legislative and Executive Councils of Uganda.
