## 2 Became Priests

DeSales '25 Class  
To Honor Mates

Geneva — Twenty-fifth ordination anniversary of two members of the Class of 1925, DeSales High School, will be noted when the priests are honored at the annual class dinner, August 28 at Canandaigua Treadway Inn, according to Mrs. Philipp Larish, 1953 chairman.

The two high school classmates are: the Rev. Frank W. Harding, pastor of St. Theresa Church, Bushville and the Rev. John Onorato, C.S.B., now in charge of Holy Family Church, Stafford, Texas and St. Teresa Mission, Sugarland, Tex. and formerly of the faculty of St. John Fisher College and Aquinas Institute, Rochester.

FATHER HARDING was ordained June 3, 1933 at St. Joseph New Cathedral, Buffalo by the late Bishop William Turner. Father Harding's major seminary was Christ the King of St. Bonaventure University. He sang his First Solemn Mass in St. Stephen Church, Geneva, accompanied by St. Stephen's Men and Boys Choir of which the priest had been a soloist since childhood.

Father Harding completed the year course at St. Stephen Elementary School in seven years and was always first in his class scholastically. Among his assignments was assistant to the late Rev. Andrew Dissett of St. Ann Church, Hornell.

FATHER ONORATO was ordained Dec. 17, 1933 in St. Michael Cathedral, Toronto, Canada by James Cardinal McGuigan.

The Christmas Eve Midnight Mass at St. Francis DeSales Church, Geneva that year, was his First Solemn Mass. During World War II he served as Lieutenant Commander in the Navy.
