Fordham Starts Stereo Radio Broadcasting

New York (NC)—Fordham University's radio station WFUV, FM will broadcast 10 hours of single-channel stereophonic programs weekly during October and November, using what is believed as a major breakthrough in three-dimensional broadcasting.

The stereophonic effect, achieved by the station, can be broadcast by a single transmitter and received on a single receiver. Until now, listeners have had to use a second receiver to get the effect.

The method used by WFUV, according to Father A. St. George, S.J., director, is called "multiplexing," which permits the simultaneous transmission of two audio signals from a single transmitter. Special multiplex receivers must be built to receive the double signals.

Multiplexing has been used on closed circuit radio transmission since 1955.
