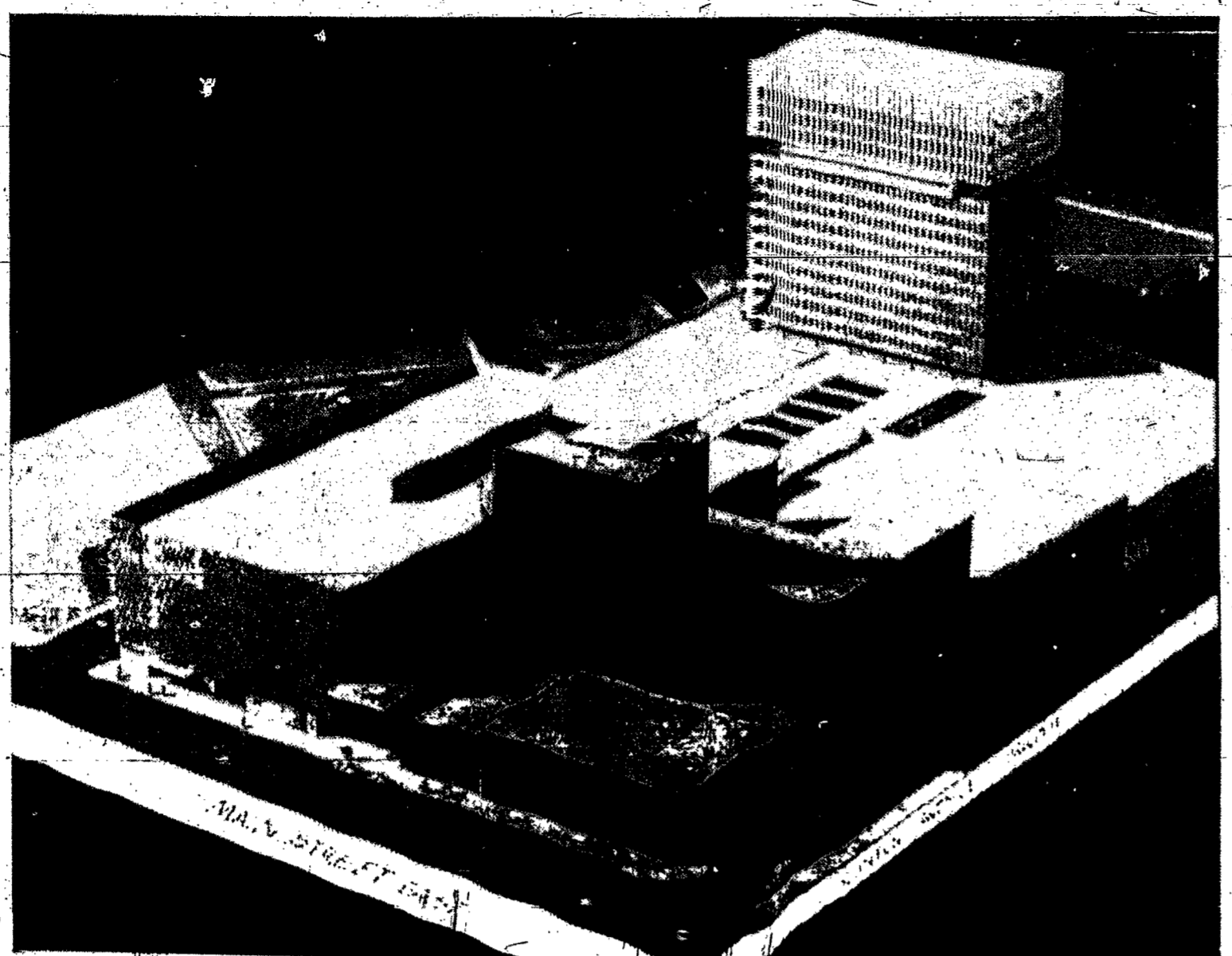

Father Cyril Carter, C.S.B., director of athletics at Aquinas Institute, informs us that Sunday, Nov. 2 has been designated homecoming game for the alumni of the institute.

Special sections of the Memorial Stadium will be reserved for the game, which pits the "Little Irish" against the Canisius High of Buffalo football team.

THE TICKETS can be obtained any day during the school week at the Devey Avenue institution or at the field on the day of the game. Game time is scheduled for 2 p.m.

The "Little Irish" got off on a winning foot last Friday night when they soundly trounced Watertown by a score of 27-7 before a crowd of about 6,000.

Five players figured in the scoring as the Aquinas gridsters scored in all but the third period. Touchdowns were made by Don Crowley on an 11-yard sweep in the first quarter, after which Bob Lambert booted the first of his three extra points.

BOBBY MIGUET, the Irish quarterback, passed to Tom Enright for 10 yards and a TD in the second quarter to make it 13-0, after which Watertown's Don Crandall went 85 yards for a touchdown on the return kickoff. Tom Crenshaw's extra point made it 13-7 at half-time.

After a scoreless third period, Joe Camillaci knifed through the Watertown defenses to block Bob Galtzer's punt early in the last period to put the Little Irish on top 20-7. Miguet went over for the last score on a one-yard sneak to make the final score 27-7.

The "Little Irish" take on the Lions of Erie Academy today at 8 p.m. at Memorial Stadium. In the first meeting between the two teams, last year, Erie scored a 39-6 victory, after heading the Aquinas team by 26-0 at half-time.
