AMONG WOMEN? Pope's Message To All

On August 29 of this year His Holiness, Pope Pius XII, addressed the Second International Congress of the Third Order of St. Dominic at Castel Gandolfo. After addressing himself to the members of the Third Order and exhorted them to follow the example of their founder, St. Dominic, the Holy Father's address to the group in words applicable to all Catholics.

"You belong to an age that sees the triumph of the machine and its tremendous accomplishments, an age of powerful and social organizations, an age in which the economy is subjected to the irresistible momentum of the modern stage."

"Without losing any of its reality, and always conscious of the spiritual weaknesses of men, which remain unchanged by all these modern inventions, the Church must live by accepting its own but irrevocable conditions."

"YOUR MEMBERSHIP in the Third Order put you immediately at a position to assist through the study of the Christian life more necessary than ever in a world created by its own inventions."

"The attention is drawn to you as a group of women, particularly suited to the most important objectives of the present-day apostolate. This is the thought we wish to touch on briefly, since it is the main theme of your Congress."

"To cultivate the spirit of faith as is required of you by your vocation, as Dominicans, you must devote a large part of your life to prayer."

"We know that usually it is not possible for you to concentrate long hours to contemplative exercises. But with the full observance of the disciplines outlined in your Rule, you must be careful to cultivate an interior state similar to that of a contemplative Religious that is to say, continuous attention to the liturgy of God, a cultivated taste for silent meditation, a fondness for the Divine word found in the Scriptures and in the liturgical offices."

"Today the letter and spirit of the Sacred Scriptures are translated more exactly and with precision and beautiful commentaries. The necessities of the world."
