

Registration Up At John Fisher

Registration at St. John Fisher College reached a new record with 475 students in course for the academic year 1958-1959 according to Gerard H. Tucker, registrar and director of admissions at the college.

This represents an increase of 63 per cent over last year's total enrollment. Freshman registrations also reached a new high with 213 new students enrolled. This figure is 14 per cent higher than the 1957-1958 freshman total Tucker said.

This is part of St. John Fisher College's continuing efforts to meet the needs of the community in providing qualified teachers for our youth. 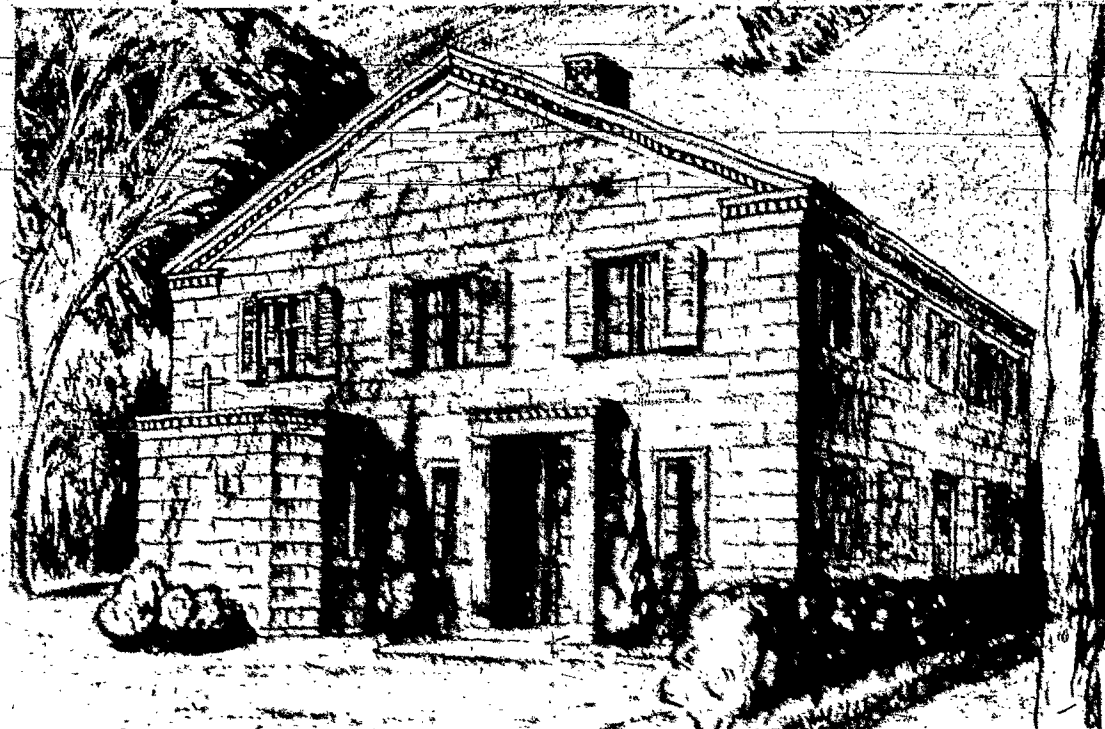
