BOOK SHELF

From Marx To Christ
By Sister Margaret Teresa, Nazareth College

"From Karl Marx To Jesus Christ," by Rev. Ignace Lepp. Sheed 38, 212 pp. \$3.75.

Ignace Lepp, after giving ten ardent years of his young manhood to Communism, was converted to the Faith by reading Sienkiewicz's "Quo Vadis."

Or rather, after total disillusionment with Russian Communism, and despair of non-Russian Communism's chances in the rest of the world, this devoted, right intellectual, a university teacher, allowed himself one night to read, for sheer interest, leisure, escape—and in "Quo Vadis" he met the early Christians. Or even more truly, grace, which "knocks in vain at the doors of a satisfied heart," invaded his "emptiness; there was clearly "a void within him which God saw fit to fill."

THE EARLY Christians were the realization of his Communist dreams. But were they real? Was it history?

"I went to the public library and began drawing up a list of all the books which dealt with the first three centuries of Christian history. Then I set to work systematically to read them. First came the novels, for I have always held that a good novelist can feel himself into the spirit of a given period even better than a learned his-torographer."

The steps thereafter are sur-

uit theologian, who gave him two and three hours every day for weeks, and moderated his bitterness against Communism! Now he learned social Catholicism from Papal Encyclicals, all the radical ideas of the Church. Fathers and of St. Thomas Aquinas, and the essential sharing-of-spiritual-which was the Mystical Body.

Then and not till then did his new friend give him religion, via the saint, St. Francis of Assisi first.

"One day I announced to my Priest that I wanted to become a Jesuit... 'Have you realized,' he said, 'that if you want to become a Jesuit you will first have to be a Catholic?'"

There are other Orders, other names, in the later story, Benedictines, Franciscans, Emmanuel Mounier, Pere Henri de Lubac—and the last word, "Everything still remains to be done," suggests that Ignace Lepp's seventeen years in the priesthood have furnished him with a lively sequel to this story.

But this book, from the last fifty pages of which I have drawn the conversion-story, is an unusual testament, from within the Party, of the growth of Communism, its absorption of two generations of young idealists, its symptoms (I hope) of decline. It explains the Communist thought-process, and how the practice of criminal tyranny can be for so long a time accepted by the sincere believer.

A Lutheran pastor taught him the continuity between the Old and the New Testaments, and the value of the Prophets—but, "When was your Church founded?" drew disappointing answers.
