The younger — and so-called "beat" — generation has taken many a verbal lashing from its elders, often with justification.

But little, if anything, is said about the ordinary high school student who goes about his business of getting a good education so that he can fill the leader's shoes of tomorrow.

THE MAJORITY OF THE students in the high schools in the Rochester Diocese fall into this second category; youngsters with an intense desire to learn, to be respected by everyone they come in contact with.

A typical example is David Balashis, son of Mr. and Mrs. Anthony Balashis of 91 Warsaw St., Rochester. He and hundreds like him belong to their school's athletic teams, serve Mass in their parish churches, belong to school clubs, spend most of their spare time studying and some even hold part-time jobs.

Dave is a sophomore student at Aquinas Institute and a member of St. George's Lithuanian Parish, Hudson Ave., Rochester.

This 15-year-old lad is by no means "beat." A conscientious boy with a definite goal in his mind, Dave could not be classified as strictly a book worm, although he spends several hours each night in study.

AN "A" STUDENT AT Aquinas, Dave is an outstanding member of his school's IV football team where he is both an end and quarterback. He also plays basketball and baseball at the Aquinas Institute.

A graduate of St. George's school, Dave wants to go to college, and eventually become a doctor. Naturally, science is his favorite subject at school.

An altar boy at St. George's Church, Dave also serves Mass at Aquinas, where he is a member of the student council. Dave is at Aquinas on a full, four year scholarship and is a member of the St. Thomas More Honor Club. He would like to be a newspaper carrier, but his other activities would interfere with that work.

THE MOST OF HIS fellow students, he is helpful around the house. His day follows a definite schedule as to home study. He has a study immediately after dinner each night for about three hours.

With so much time devoted to sports, Dave doesn't have too much free time, and he finds no time to fool around with gangs. He reads as much as possible and takes in a movie every once in a while.

With such a busy schedule, Dave has no time to get into trouble — just as the greatest majority of students have no time to "fool around."
