Paris - (RNS) - A clean shirt a day saved his life, says Father Andre Dupeyrat, French Roman Catholic missionary among the Papuans of New Guinea,

Father Dupeyrat, a member of the company of Priest Brothers of Issoudun, described his extraordinary escape from a horrible death when he appeared on a popular radio program "The Escape Club" on the No. 1 Europe network.

In 30 years of missionary work among the primitive Christianity but in doing so he incurred the hatred of the witch doctors who saw their power over the people seriously

The witch doctors finally decided to act. They held a "trial" which was in fact a long session of ritual dances and ended with the priest being condemned to die. The sentence was to be carried out by a two yard long snake, black striped with blood red rings. Its bite is extremely painful and the agony lasts from ten to 15 minutes.
