Sixth Happiness Heads For Oscar

One of the great pictures of the year, "The Inn of the Sixth Happiness," now playing at Rochester's Palace Theater, has been made from Alan Burgess' novel, "The Small Woman." This story of a dedicated woman with a love of people, and especially children, runs the gamut of emotions in most effective fashion. "Sixth Happiness" is one of those rare pictures that weaves a spell over the beholder and then lingers in the memory.

The movie glorifies and romanticizes the true story of Gladys Aylward, an English servant girl with little formal education, but with the inner drive to dedicate her life to help the downtrodden people of China. This Buddy Adler production was filmed in Wales where an entire Chinese village was recreated. The Oriental style is enhanced by CinemaScope and Deluxe Color.

INGRID BERGMAN plays the lead role for which, this reviewer predicts, she will at least receive a nomination for the coveted Academy Award.

The late Robert Donat is the mandarin ruler of Yangcheng. He leaves his fans with a performance that is a superb swan-song. It is a highlight of his career as was his work in "Goodbye Mr. Chips." Now in reality, we must say, Goodbye Mr. Donat.

Curt Jurgens, of submarine fame, has the other major male role of the Eurasian officer in the Chinese Army. The only adverse opinion of this reviewer is that the long and dangerous trek with a caravan of 100 children over enemy ridden mountains could have been shortened.

What is the "Sixth Happiness?" The movie gives one answer but this reviewer will answer the question by saying that the "6th" is the enjoyment and warmth you'll have by seeing this one. Be sure to bring the kids.
