

Miracle Leads Actor To Faith

Paris — (RNS) — British actor Alec Guinness, who was knighted by Queen Elizabeth in the New Year's Honors list was converted to Roman Catholicism in 1956 after the seemingly miraculous cure of his son Matthew, a polio victim, according to the Paris weekly, France Dimanche.

The magazine said the 15-year-old boy was able to get up and walk six months after his father visited the Catholic church of St. Lawrence in Petersfield, England; and prayed for his son.

The star of the box-office hit, "The Bridge on the River Kwai," vowed that if his son was cured he would enter the Catholic Church. On April 2, 1956, the 42-year-old actor received his first Communion at St. Lawrence's.

Matthew had been paralyzed since the age of five, when he contracted polio. His father had consulted doctors all over the world, but none had been able to do anything for the boy. While working on the film "Coriolan," Sir Alec one day entered the Petersfield church to ask God's help.

Since his son's cure, which he believes to be a miracle, Sir Alec has attended church every day, the Paris publication stated. Sir Alec Guinness was the last visitor received in audience by Pope Pius XII before his death.

Watching The Screen

Guilty Or Not Guilty?

"I WANT TO LIVE" comes to Rochester's Loew's Theater next week and brings to the screen a story that divided California into two camps in 1954.

It may well be that truth is stranger than fiction but this reviewer will not vouch for the

truth and nothing but the truth in this morbidly dramatic film for the real truth of this story is still under debate.

Just last month the Los Angeles Police Department bitterly denounced this movie as a film of "half truths and propaganda." The Deputy District Attorney of the same city labeled the picture as an obvious attempt to influence public opinion against capital punishment.

Hollywood fights back shouting that "I Want To Live" is not a story sprung from an author's vivid imagination nor is it fiction, but fact with truth as its added dimension.

Not having a degree in law, this reviewer will not help re-litigate the controversy that has surrounded the case for over five years. Adults can form their own opinions, as this is strictly ADULT fare.

This 120 minute exercise in tension tells the story of Barbara Graham, her trial for the Monahan murder, her conviction on circumstantial evidence and gas chamber execution. The story unfolds from the viewpoint of San Francisco reporter Edward Montgomery (played well by Shiraz Durrani) who first is against "Babs" and then befriends her right up to the grim end.

Susan Hayward plays the tough, hardboiled, fast, crude, sordid Barbara Graham. Miss Hayward's acting attains an all-time high and her portrayal should again see her nominated for an Academy Award as the year's best actress.

The film's horrifying power is an intimate impression of how it feels to wait for death with the gas chamber next door. The film is quite depressing and morbid. Adults, liking this type, will eat it up, but, please, don't let children or teenagers even taste it. There was only one Barbara Graham. Let's have no more.
