Prelate Warns Against Red Movies

Waltham, Mass. — (RNS) — Richard Cardinal Cushing, Archbishop of Boston, warned that Soviet Russia soon will send to American theaters Communist produced movies "based on atheistic principles."

He addressed 1,000 members and guests of Waltham Council Knights of Columbus at Brandeis University's Shapiro Athletic Center here.

He said Deputy Premier Mikoyan wanted to talk to the moguls of the motion picture industry in Hollywood "to encourage film exchanges."

Cardinal Cushing said such films include those of Lenin and Stalin.
