

## Boston Jews Hail Cardinal

Boston — (RNS) — Richard Cardinal Cushing, Archbishop of Boston, was honored as the "Man of the Year" by the Jewish Advocate, English-language weekly published here, for his outstanding achievements as a churchman, orator and administrator.

A long laudatory citation said the award was given to the Roman Catholic prelate in appreciation of his contribution to inter-racial understanding, human betterment and civic progress.

"If the cardinal's noble thoughts against racial antipathy and creedal strife could be put into the hearts of every man and child," the Advocate declared, "then verily would we arrive at the long overdue recognition that we are all children of One Loving Father to enjoy the pleasantness of brethren in living together in peace."

## Sodality Rite Fills St. Michael's Church

Over 11,000 teenagers packed vast St. Michael's Church Rochester, Monday evening for a Candlemas Day ceremony closing the Lourdes Centenary Year.

Bishop Kearney celebrated high Mass and gave the sermon.

HE OUTLINED the story of the presentation of the Christ Child in the Temple — terming the event "the first Christian pilgrimage." The presentation feast is popularly called Candlemas Day from the liturgical custom of blessing candles on that date.

The Bishop also gave blessed candles to representatives of parish and school Sodality organizations.

THE CEREMONY was the sixth annual Candlemas Day rite arranged by the diocesan wide Sodality program. The Sodality also made the responses in Latin throughout the Mass.

Receiving the blessed candle from the Bishop were representative from forty-two parish Sodalities, two college Sodality groups and six high school groups. Besides Rochester parishes, Fairport, Henrietta, Webster, Brockport, Wayland and Canandaigua parishes had Sodalists attending the rite.

Assisting Bishop Kearney at the Mass were priest directors of the various Sodalities. Choir portions of the Mass were taken by students from St. Agnes high school and the "Benedictines" of the Nazareth College Glee Club.
