

On 'MD International'

The medical work American-born nuns and nurses are doing in Korea will be highlighted for 10 minutes on a color television program to be rebroadcast on Feb. 22.

Entitled "MD International," the program will be seen in Rochester on WRCOTV, Chan-

nel 5 at 5 p.m. on Sunday.

The film opens with pictures of the work of the Maryknoll Sisters in Korea. In the war-ravaged city of Pusan, Korean-American-born and trained women doctors and nurses, members of the Maryknoll Sisters, care for as many as 1,000 patients a day.

"MD INTERNATIONAL" received unprecedented praise from TV critics, the viewing public, members of the medical profession and the clergy when it was originally presented in January, 1958.

John Daly, award-winning radio and television newscaster, musical narrator, panel moderator, and network executive, will speak at St. Bonaventure University's Press Day, May 7.

Regarded as the busiest man broadcasting today, the 45-year-old Daly will be the main guest at a luncheon in the university's main dining hall. About 1400 business, faculty, members and high school students are expected to hear him. Daly will fly to Olean by private plane and return to New York in time for his regular radio and television news shows.
