### Bona Lists John Daly At Press Day

St. Bonaventure, N. Y. — John H. Daily, award-winning radio and television newscaster, musical narrator, panel moderator, and network executive, will speak at St. Bonaventure University's Press Day, May 7.

Regarded as the busiest man in broadcasting today, the 45-year-old Daily will be the main guest at a luncheon in the university's main dining hall, about 1400 newsmen, family members and high school students are expected to hear him. Daily will fly to Olean by private plane and return to New York a time for his regular radio and television news shows.
