St. Thomas Aquinas

By MARY LENNON SNYDER. Since tomorrow is the feast of St. Thomas Aquinas, I should like to speak of him today in the words of one of his most ardent admirers, G. K. Chesterton.

In an introductory preface Chesterton declared that his first interest in writing on St. Thomas was to give a "popular sketch of a great historical figure"; yet he did not insult the popular intelligence.

Rather he wrote what has been widely acclaimed as one of the finest introductions to St. Thomas Aquinas and his works.

From time to time I intend to re-read parts of his book, but I want to find myself carried along to finish it as I was on the occasion of my first reading.

The copy I own is in the Image Book edition, price seventy-five cents which puts it within the reach of the most modest book budgets.

I include this information, as I am sure that this is a book which many of my readers would find not easy, but most rewarding, reading.
