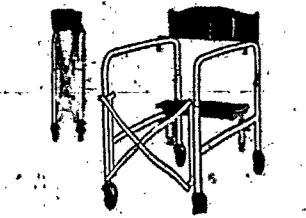
**Vicar General Pontificates**
