

Aquinas, McQuaid Seniors Take National Awards

Two local Catholic high school seniors are among 750 members of this year's U.S. secondary school graduating classes to share in more than \$3.5 million in college scholarships from the National Merit Scholarship Corporation.

Honorary scholarships were awarded to Douglas Maguire, Penfield, of McQuaid Jesuit High School, and Brian L. Gibson, of Aquinas Institute.

MORE THAN 480,000 high school seniors across the nation—about 32 per cent of all seniors—took examinations which narrowed the field to the 750 winners who will receive four-year scholarships to the institution of their choice.

Each scholarship recipient receives funds according to his need. The average stipend for this year's winners is \$730 a

year, the corporation said, adding that exact figures for recipients are considered confidential. The minimum is \$100 a year and the maximum is \$1,500. Most scholarships also provide a grant to the college or university selected by the scholar.
