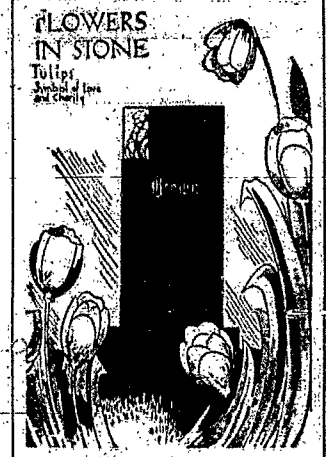

Divine Word Brother Joachim Oros, St. Michael's Pioneer, Marks 25 Years

Brother Joachim Oros, one of the pioneers of St. Michael's Divine Word Seminary, observed the Silver Jubilee of his religious profession on May 6. Previous to this, on May 1, Brother Joachim, together with his confreres Brother Gregory Koch of Girard, Pa., solemnly renewed his vows in a combination ceremony which also saw six postulants invested with the habit of lay brother and received into the Novitiate of the Society.

BROTHER JOACHIM has many friends especially among the dealers of O-Neh-Da altar wines since he has been working in the winery for many years. He was one of the first pioneers to come to St. Michael's after it was opened as a seminary in 1935.

He first gave his services as cook to the small band of Divine Word Missionaries who for several years already had been living and working on the old "Bishop's Farm" of Bishop McQuaid.

Brother was one of the group who chose the site for the building of the new seminary.

and saw the institution grow from the Bishop's frame summer cottage to the group of buildings that stands today. THE JUBILARIAN made his first profession at Tebnay, Illinois in 1934. McAuley College Given State OK

The Board of Regents announced the granting of an absolute charter to Catherine McAuley Junior College, conducted by the Sisters of Mercy of Rochester, in action taken May 1 in Albany.

The college is authorized to grant the Associate in Applied Science degree for three years of college studies, the fourth year to be pursued at a major college for the completion of the undergraduate program and the obtaining of a degree.

CATHERINE McAULEY Junior College was granted a temporary five-year charter by the New York State Education Department in 1954. The major recommendation made by the University of the State of New York was that a separate building be constructed for the college, according to Sister Mary de Pazzi, Dean of Instruction.
