Camp Offers New Rate Plan

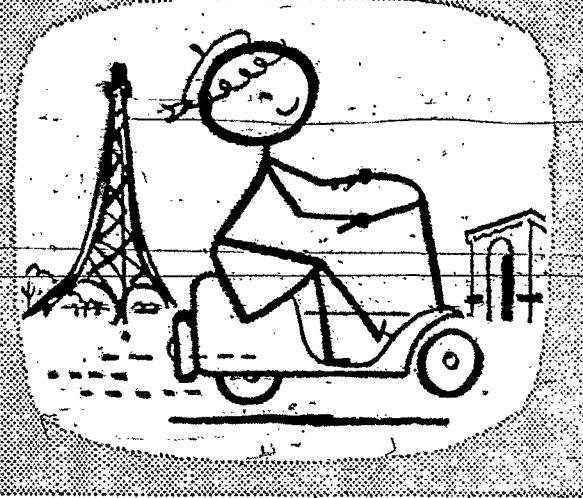
