**High School Planned in Fr. Dowd's Mission**

Erection of a Jesuit High School in Formosa on property acquired under the direction of Father Louis J. Dowd, S.J., formerly of Rochester is planned soon.

Father Dowd informed friends of his mission of this in a letter to Harold J. Coleman, president of Will Corporation, this week.

Father Dowd formerly of Blessed Sacrament parish was ordained to the Priesthood while in a Japanese prison camp in 1944. When he was home in 1953 he told of his plans for a school in Formosa. He is director of the Youth and Catechetical Training Center, Catholic Mission, Hainchu, Taiwan.

THE PROPOSED high school, Father Dowd said, "will be a perfect complement to our Center and complete our plans for a Jesuit formation for Taiwan's youth."

The Center, he explained is primarily pre-seminary. Ten boys are well on the road with definite vocations. A year from now the new Novitiate will open in Chang Hwa and the objective is to fill it from Father Dowd's center.

Father Dowd commended Coleman for his cooperation in advancing the Catholic faith among youth of Formosa. He thanked all who have helped in his work and asked continued prayers as well as financial aid.
