

### St. Agnes High Teacher Tops History Essay Contest

Sister M. Edwaine, teacher of history at St. Agnes High School, was awarded first prize in Monroe County for her essay on the projects initiated by her and her history students in connection with the observance of the 350th Anniversary of the Hudson Champlain Landing in 1609.

In the teacher division, second place is held by Miss Judith Anderson of Our Lady of Mercy High School, with third place held by Sister Miriam of Nazareth Academy. Sister Edwaine will receive a gold medal at the Rochester Museum of Arts and Sciences on the evening of June 10. Miss Anderson and Sister Miriam will receive silver and bronze medals.

Highlighting the projects carried out by SAIL seniors under the leadership of Sister Edwaine, was a Martha Washington Tea, complete with period costumes from the authentic wardrobe of the Rochester Chapter of the D.A.R.

Throughout the year, Rochester historic sites were visited by the group and in May program was concluded with a tour of the Granger home in Canastota and the Seagrave home in Albion.

Sister Edwaine's essay was sent to Albany to be reviewed and judged in the State Department of Education for final award, a trip to Europe.
