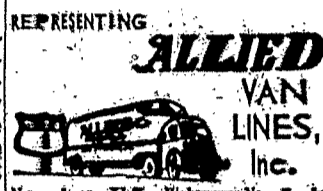

### Outdoor Rite To Spur Drive

Proposed school expansion — Architect's rendering shows Holy Apostles School, Austin Street and Lyell Avenue, as it will appear after the proposed addition of six rooms (portion at right of building). Addition includes four new classrooms and two meeting rooms. Plans also include renovation of the existing 12-classroom building and additional space for parking. Pledges toward the project will be sought in parishwide solicitation slated this Sunday, June 7, and on Sunday, June 14. Minimum goal is \$200,000.
