Church Ideals Seen In Cuba Reform Laws

Havana — Cuba's new land reform law is in line with some of the Church's social teachings, Catholic. observers here are noting.

They point out that the law, approved by Premier Fidel Castro on May 17, aims at the welfare of families and not only individuals, and respects the right

of private ownership.
In a front-page article in the daily Avance here, Franciscan Father Luis de Zavala wrole that the land reform may usher in "a milestone of prosperity" if it is carried out with determination and

He said that everything de-pends on whether those who drew up the new law, greetedenthusiastically by the peo ple, have enough "will pow-er" to translate its provisions

· The law was approved at h cabinet meeting in La Plata in Oriente province, strong-hold of the Castro forces dur-ing their struggle against the dictatorship of former President Fulgencio Balista, who was ousted last January.

It extends to the whole country the reforms started by the Castro forces in areas it controlled before taking
