Catholic Candidate Faces Loss Of Votes

New York - (RNS) - Any Roman Catholic cant didate for President next year is bound to lose some votes because of his religion, Sen, John J. Sparkman (D. Ala.) said in a recorded radio interview here.

"I think the issue of Catholicism. will-have some effect," he said, "just like Gov. Adlai Stevenson's belonging to the Unitarian Church cost-him-voles because he adheres to a faith that does not admit to the divinity of Christ."

SEN. SPARKMAN said there is a "rather strong feeling" on the part of a great number of people against the idea of a Catholic as President. "That undoubtedly will have some effect," he said, but added, "I doubt very seriously that it is anything like as strong as it was in 1928 when Al Smith was the candidate."

Sen. Sparkman is regarded as a leader in the liberal group of Southern senators. He was Mr. Steven-son's running mate for Vice President on the Demo-cratic ticket in 1952.
