Requiem Mass for Sister Mary Frederic Frisch, a native of Rochester was offered at Villa Maria, North Hill, Md., near Baltimore on July 1.

Sister Mary Frederic, a School Sister of Notre Dame who taught in two Catholic elementary schools in Rochester died June 29, 1959 at the villa. She was the daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. Frederic A. Frisch. Mr. Frisch was a tinsmith.

AFTER GRADUATING from St. Michael's School, Rochester Sister Mary Frederic worked several years as a tailor and dressmaker for Anna Meyer, who operated a shop in Hollenbeck Street.

She entered the order in Baltimore and for a time was in charge of teaching novices.

Her first teaching assignment was at St. Boniface School. After two years she returned to Baltimore. She taught there and in Connecticut before returning here to teach in Holy Family School.

Sister Mary Frederic was stricken with a heart ailment and spent several months in St. Mary's Hospital here. She then went back to the villa.

Surviving are four sisters, Mrs. Joseph A. Dopez, Margaret Frisch, Mrs. John Beerly and Albertine Frisch, all of Rochester, and several nieces and nephews.
