

**Realtors Again
Break Records**

Figures released by William C. Kane, president of the Real Estate Board of Rochester, show that sales consummated through Realtor Multiple Listing Service for the first half of 1959 numbered 2166 parcels of property. This compares with 1664 for the same period of 1958, and is an increase of 29% over last year and the most active six months in the history of the Board, which had its beginning in 1910.

The month of June, just passed, says Kane, also set a record surpassing any other month in the Board's history with 335 sales recorded by Realtors in that month alone.

"An interesting sidelight on the reviewing of activity figures in Real Estate sold by Realtors is the fact that there is greater activity during the second six months of the year than during the first half. This has been true every year without exception for more than ten years past," Kane concluded.

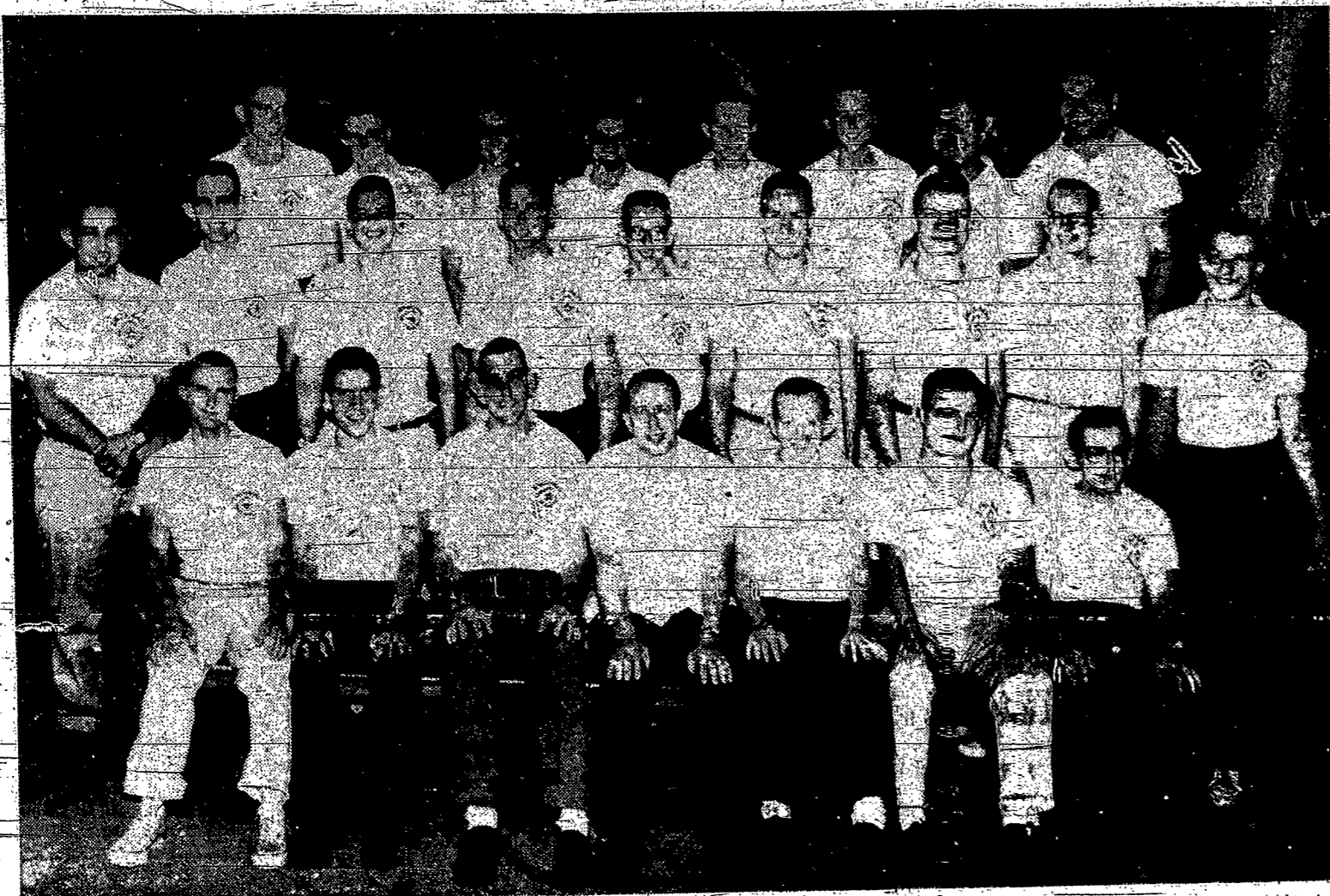

Clyde - Death came twice in two weeks with the death of Joseph Janio, brother of Friar Stephen Janio, O.P.M., of Siena College, and Sister M. Daniel of Holy Family Aubin. Mr. Janio, 60, died at Doctor's Hospital, Baltimore, Maryland, June 27, 1959.

He was home in Clyde two weeks ago to attend the funeral of his father, Michael Janio. He was born in Clyde, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Michael Janio.

A procession will follow to his grave in nearby Holy Cross cemetery where he is buried in the same general plot which contains his mother and father.
