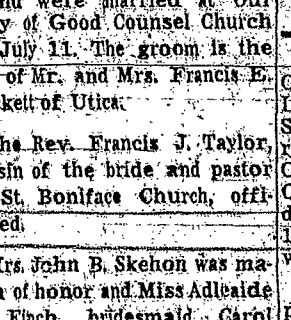

Turntable Talk . . .
Opera

MOZART: La Nozze di Figaro, Cezare Siepi, Hilde Gueden, Lisa della Casa, Alfred Poell, Suzanne Danco, Fernando Corengo, Vienna State Opera Chorus, Vienna Philharmonic Orchestra, Erich Kleiber conducting (London stereo OS 1402, monaural A 4407, 4 LPs with libretto).

The monaural version of this performance, which has already been available for some time, is widely recognized as one of the finest musical offerings available on long play records. The new dimension of stereophonic sound presents the same great performance with vastly increased dramatic and musical impact—vivid stage presence of the voices, clear and delicate definition for the ensemble singing and for the orchestra.

If there is a weak point anywhere in the cast, it is probably in Suzanne Danco's Cherubino, but even at its worst the singing is much better than adequate. At its best (in Siepi's impeccable singing and acting of the title role) this production is magnificent, and the general level of the singing is excellent.

The sensitive and carefully paced conducting of the late Erich Kleiber was largely responsible for this near-perfect production, but all hands, including the orchestra, singers and recording engineers, deserve applause.

The value of the music hardly needs to be mentioned. "The Marriage of Figaro" has often been called "the greatest of all comic operas," and except for another composition about the same characters, Rossini's "Barber of Seville," it has virtually no serious contenders for the title.

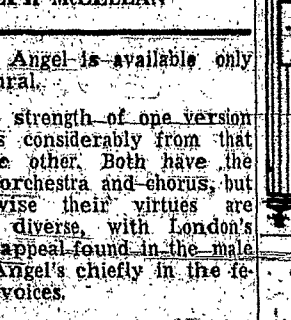
