Twelfth annual novena in honor of St. Anne will be held at St. Anne's Church, Rochester, from Sunday, July 19 until Monday, July 27.

The new St. Anne's Church features a reproduction of the world-famous Murillo painting of St. Anne and the Blessed Virgin Mary.

A Solemn Mass on the feast day, July 26, will take place at 10 a.m.

The novena will be conducted by the Rev. Alban Lynch, C.P.

DAILY MASSES during the novena will be offered at 6, 7, 7:30 and 9 a.m.

Evening services consisting of the Rosary of St. Anne, sermon, novena prayers and Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament will begin at 7:45.

Leaflets will be distributed free at the church.

The Rev. Albert J. Geiger, pastor of Holy Ghost Church, Coldwater Rd., has announced that on the Feast of St. Anne (July 26th) Mass will be celebrated at the Lourdes Grotto on the terrace of the church at 7:30 p.m., as an accommodation for shut-ins and for any who may find it convenient to receive Holy Communion in their cars. This will be in addition to the regular Sunday Masses which are celebrated at 8, 9, 10 and 12 and the public is invited.

Lawyer Opens Own Office


