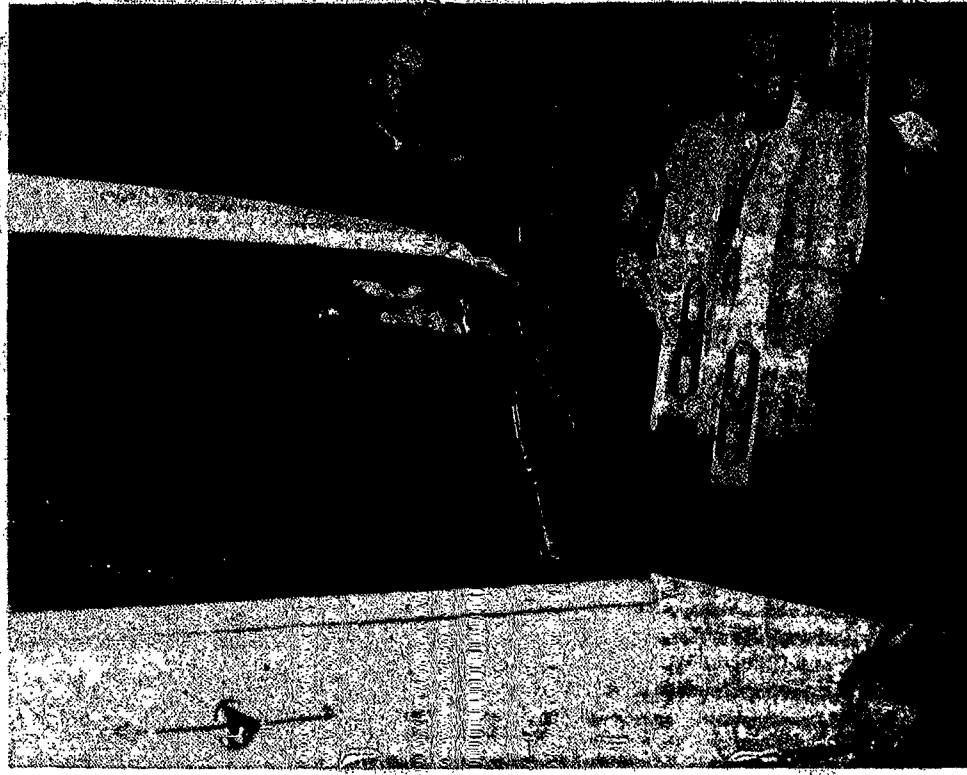


Open House, Dinner Set At Conesus
