Among Women Shrines

As I have mentioned previously, we spent our vacation this summer in Canada. In preparation for the trip I read as much as possible about the places I intended to visit.

Since the culture of French Canada is basically Catholic, I was not surprised to discover that I was reading about famous shrines and religious leaders.

Even the most cursory description of the city of Montreal includes a reference to the Oratory of St. Joseph and to Brother Andre. Since I knew about this famous lay brother only in the sketchiest of outlines, I decided upon my return home to learn more.

In view of this I remember that I had heard a fellow Australian, Neil O'Connell say that during his childhood he had read a book which told the parish priest in his home town.

DISCUSSING the matter with her, I learned that she owned a story of his life written by a priest of the Congregation of the Holy Cross in order to which Brother Andre belonged.

One of the details of the life of Brother Andre which impressed me most forcefully was the tremendous influence his mother had upon him. If one read his life story as an anonymous case history, one could spot many factors in his childhood which would indicate that his adult life might be spent as a burden to society.
