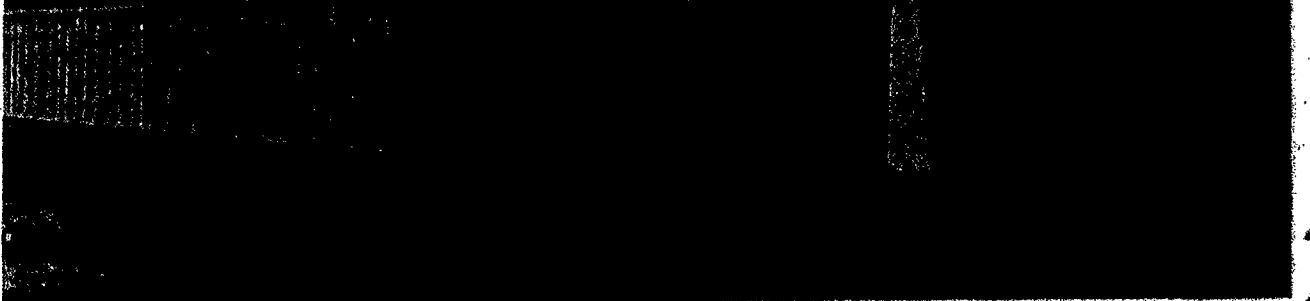

**Lawyers' Annual Red Mass To Mark Opening Of Courts**

Bishop Kearney will celebrate the annual Lawyers' Red Mass and preach the sermon, Wednesday, Sept. 16 at St. Joseph's Church, Franklin St., Rochester.

General chairman for the 14th annual Red Mass, which marks the opening of the courts of justice in Rochester and the Seventh Judicial District is the Honorable Daniel J. O'Mara, Supreme Court Justice.

Inaugurated by Bishop Kearney in 1945, the Red Mass has been celebrated since medieval times in most European countries at the opening of new court terms to invoke the blessing of the Holy Spirit on the courts of justice. The Mass takes its name from the color of the vestments worn by the celebrant.

To make observance of the Red Mass more widespread, Justice O'Mara has appointed a Public Officers committee with judges and lawyers in the seven counties of the Seventh Judicial District not representing Monroe; a citizens committee in Rochester; a judges committee and a public officers committee for Monroe County.
