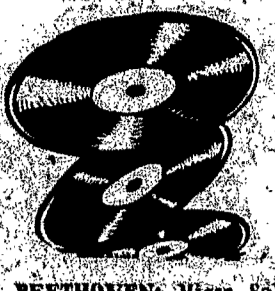

and the chorus rather more than adequate, but the Beethoven score makes virtually impossible demands.

There is no such thing as a perfect performance of the Beethoven Missa Solemnis and there never will be until human vocal chords can be modified to meet Beethoven's specifications.

There HAS probably been more nonsense written about the Beethoven Missa Solemnis than about any other religious composition in the history of music.

It is also partly due to the fact that, although this is one of the most impressive existing recordings of a mass text it is obviously suited for performance in a church.

Among all the things that have been said and written about the Missa Solemnis, probably the last word is the first written by the composer.

ALOHIA OE E MALIA (Ave Maria) St. Catherine's Choir, Rev. John H. McDonald, S.M., director (AM recordings).

Much of the Hawaiian music you hear on records is performed by people who have never been near the Islands.

St. Catherine's choir is made up of high schoolers from the parish on Kauai Island.

Their repertoire includes many colorful Hawaiian songs (including an Ave Maria in their native language) plus some borrowings, such as "Way down yonder in my tropical land."

BESIDES THEIR Hawaiian Ave Maria, religious items on the record include five Latin hymns — two of them very complex polyphonic items by Josquin des Pres and Palestrina.

MY FAIR LADY — Brilliant melodic adaptation of the comic opera about the Cockney flower girl transformed by the proud professor of speech.

ONCE MORE WITH FEELING — Brisk, jazz-like satirizing the limitations of fanatical concert musicians.

RASHOMON — Odd, violent drama of a crime scene, completely probing the mobility of most human motives.

REDEEMED — Snappy musical comedy of romance and shipboard life.

THE WHEEL OF THE SAINTS — Boiling about-face comedy in which the cantankerous old blind man is depicted as a saint.

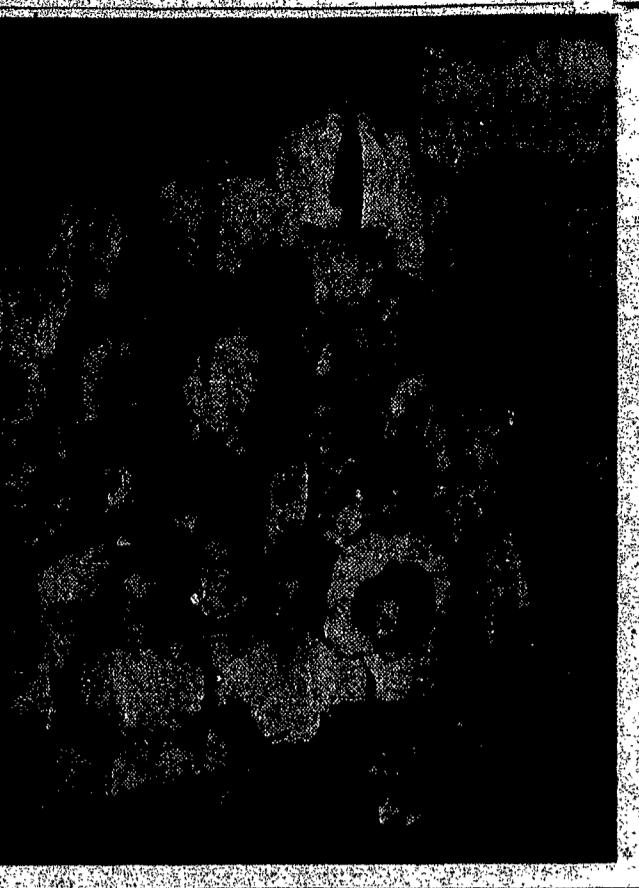
THE WORLD OF SUZUKI WONG — Painfully sentimental look at a Chinese girl who is a dental humorist.

Watching The Screen 'It's Coming'

"The gates of St. Peter are open to you." With these portentous words, a Vatican dignitary last May informed Austrian director Ernst Marischka that Pope Pius XII, for the first time in the history of the papacy, had approved the shooting (in color) of a full-length dramatic film, "EMBEZZLED HEAVEN," in which the Pope would appear as an integral part of the plot.

This film will have its local premiere at the Regent Theater in early October.
