# 'For Free -- Money'

Yes, you read it right. Again, we are offering to the elementary and high school students of Rochester and surrounding communities the opportunity to see top-notch entertainment and to tell us why they enjoyed the movie. That great stuff called money, is waiting for the winners.

The contest centers around the outstanding Catholic film "EMBEZZLED HEAVEN," which is coming to the Regent Theater on Friday, Oct. 9th. This superb film has been given the encouragement and blessing of the Holy See — the first time to my knowledge, such official approval has been given to a commercial film.

High officials of the Vatican examined the shooting script minutely before giving permission to use locations which, for centuries, have been the sites of Holy Pilgrimages, most of which have never before been made available to a film company.

## Missionary Film Series Slated For WVET-TV

Produced by the Rev. Charles Erb, S.V.D., native of Rochester and manager of the Mission Scenepama held at the War Memorial, a series of Divine Word Presentations in color will be seen on WVET-TV, Channel 10 on four successive Saturdays beginning Oct. 3 at 2 p.m.

The half-hour series will open with "Letters from India," a travelogue-type show with continuous action and background. Rev. Gerard Hofstee of St. Veron, Washington, who has spent almost a quarter of a century in the Divine Word Mission of India, writes to his friend, Val Bracco, who describes the travels and work of the priest in India.

THE NEXT presentation on October 10 at 2 p.m. will be an Indonesian Passion Play. This is a play-within-a-play type show. Sister Francetta, Holy Ghost nun who tells sixth-graders about the Indonesians, their pagan and Christian art and the work of missionaries among them is a veteran missionary.

On October 17 at 2 p.m., the film in color will be entitled "Anthropologist" and will depict Dr. William Schmidt, S.V.D., world-famous anthropologist and linguist. This shows how science can be an approach and aid to missionary work. Included will be Dr. Ralph Whiting, S.V.D., malologist from Chicago presenting Dr. Schmidt's activities. Dr. Martin Guinde, who has done outstanding research work among the pigmy tribes of the world and among Indian tribes of North and South America and scenes in the laboratory of Dr. Louis Lubek, who tells the story among the headhunters of New Guinea.

THE FINAL FILM on October 24 will present SVD Japan. Dr. Anthony Zimmerman SVD with 10 years experience in Japan tells a dramatic story of the Church's attempt to bring Christianity to Japan.

Victor's stereo recording is a delight to both ears. I particularly like the sharp sound of the pizzicatos, which fairly leap at the listener from both the soloist and the orchestra.

On the other hand, the four drum notes that open the concerto and play such an important thematic role in the first movement are strangely muted. This is probably intentional, since some commentators have described this bit of scoring as a touch of "mystery."

If you think of music only as something that can be whistled, Beethoven's triple concerto will probably not give you complete satisfaction. But if you delight in intricacies of texture, delicate balance and rich development of thematic material, you will find these qualities abundantly in this unique trio.
