

Pastor Moves Into Rectory At Apalachin

The new rectory, a six-room, ranch-type house, was purchased by the parish from Michael Ziemba, a former resident of Apalachin, who has moved from the area.

Keys to the rectory were presented to Father Jankowiak on Friday, Sept. 18, by John McGivern, St. and Joseph Valabek, trustees of the church.

Rectory is located on New Street, Apalachin, directly opposite the church.
