The lightning pen of George Bernard Shaw is translated this week to the screen of the Loew's Theater in 'THE DEVIL'S DISCIPLE' for ADULTS AND ADOLESCENTS.

Gilt-edge marquee names of Burt Lancaster, Kirk Douglas, and Laurence Olivier top this 82 minute movie about the American Revolution in 1777. The hanging of a rebel by British troops in a small New Hampshire town brings out a show of force by the colonists, though they are without a leader.

He appears in the person of a preacher and the film follows the stultification of a strapping parson from a man of peace to a man of action, whose battle for freedom inspires help even from the village trouble-maker, the devil's disciple.

His comedy flair is at its best in his peppery impatience with the British Army blunders and in the trial scene. One might even wish that there was more of Johnny in a role that has already been expanded.

So, there you have it. It isn't too fast-moving but for an evening on the town you should enjoy yourself at the Loew's Theater.

2,300 See New Opera In Boston Cathedral

Boston — (NC) — Some 2,300 persons filled Boston's Holy Cross Cathedral for an unprecedented performance of a widely acclaimed opera depicting the martyrdom of one of the Church's saints.

They saw the New England premiere of "Assassino nella Cattedrale" — an opera by Italian composer Idebrando Pizzetti, based on T. S. Eliot's verse drama "Murder in the Cathedral."

Critics praised the opera and its large cast. They said His Eminence Richard Cardinal Cushing, Archbishop of Boston, had set "a splendid precedent" in sponsoring the performance.

IN A TALK during intermission, the Cardinal said the opera was intended "to inaugurate a program of religious drama and of religious art."

The opera had its world premiere in March, 1938, at the famous La Scala opera house in Milan. Later a commendable performance was given in Rome for His Holiness Pope John XXIII.

THE MUSIC drama tells the story of St. Thomas a Becket, Archbishop of Canterbury, England, from 1162 until his assassination by four knights of King Henry II on December 29, 1170.

Newspaper critics writing after its Boston performance pointed out that the opera's story has special significance today. Wrote one critic:

"Murder in the Cathedral, with its affirmation of the spiritual freedom of man and its protest against the ruthless powers of the state, has a timelessness as we consider such late-day Eckberts and Steppenwolf and Mindzenty."

On the "pop" side this week, the exotic sounding Martin Denny on Liberty released another exotic sound. This one's called "The Enchanted Sea."

AND NOW TO BETTER THINGS. The year-old "Warner Brothers" label has steadily released quality. This month — one called "Bernstein's Broadway."

Columbia has put another new face into the already overcrowded record business. The record came to us bound in an eight-page folder containing baby pictures, adult pictures, and grand exclamations on the new young singer, Crash Chaddock.

Command — a new label. The first two releases are "Persuasive Percussion" and "Million Dollar Sound. The recording quality of both albums is excellent and the arrangements (through a bit Latin all the way through) are interesting and worth listening to.

ONE OF THE finest things to happen to the record business is the appearance of "The Battle Hymn of the Republic" by the Mormon Tabernacle Choir and Eugene Ormandy and the Philadelphia Symphony Orchestra, on the top list of hits.

Decca's "The Flight of the Didi Lama" by Werner Muller seems destined to make some "noise" in the sales department. It's a plunk-plunk affair with lots of violins, voices and woodwinds. A nice melody is thrown in, too.

"Talk To Me" and "They Came To Cordura" on Capitol are a couple of dandy ballads, sung by the dandy of them all, Frank Sinatra, enriched of course by the masterful arrangements of Nelson Riddle.

WE CAN'T SEEM to escape that "Three Penny Opera." This show, now in its fourth year in an off-Broadway theater, keeps reminding us that it is there. The newest reminder is "Mack the Knife," formerly "Morit," formerly "Theme From Three Penny Opera." This one is sung

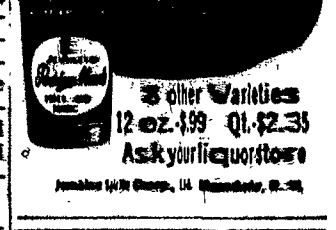
