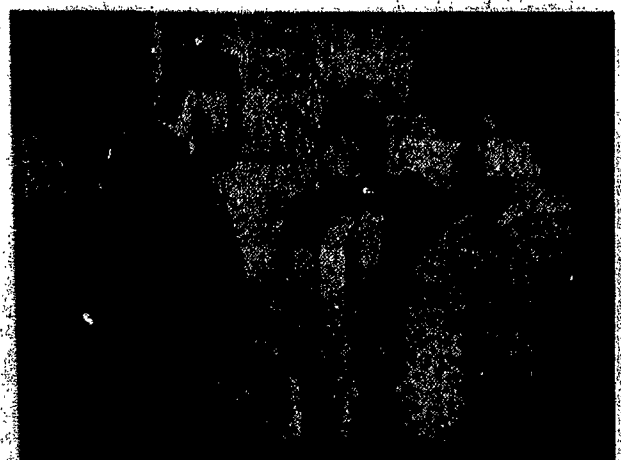

His son, Rev. Bernard V. Kuchman, an assistant pastor at Holy Redeemer Church, was celebrant of the Solemn Requiem Mass, assisted by Rev. William Amann, deacon, and Rev. Rev. Mrs. Frank J. Hoefen as subdeacon.

Rev. Joseph F. Reinhart was Master of Ceremonies; Rev. Father William Trent and George S. Wood were acolytes, and Rev. Elmer J. Schmidt was thurifer.

BISHOP KEARNEY gave the absolution. The Priests' Choir was under the direction of Rev. Charles McGarity.
