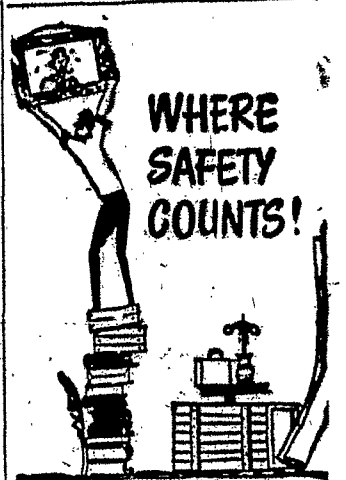
Sacred Heart Readies Team
