## On Decline

Miami - (NC) - Active pa ticipation by Cuba's Catholics n spiritual devolions is on the decline and a Invaria Catholic publication is under attack for its criticisms of the new Cuba rogime, according to an Eng-lish priest who arrived here from Cuba.

"Attendance at Mass has do creased in marked numbers during past months," said Father Joseph Cliff, a native of York-shire, England, who left San-tiago on November 6 after sorving as an assistant for one year at the Cathedral there.

"The number of civil mar-riages is incremeng," he added "and common law marriages are being legalized en masse sometimes as many as 50 couples at'a time." .

During an interview here, Father Cliff pointed out that Diario de La Marina, Catholic publication in Elvana, had been "very brave" in its editorial criticism of Field Castro's government, but as a result has been the victim of physical at-tacks by mobsters on its Havana offices. At the present time, he said, the publication scens to "be afraid" of making further ditorial commont.
