## GOD LOVE YOU!

In days of prosperity, Bishops are primarily administrators; in days of adversity, their role is principally that of shepherd. In days of relative peace the laity are divided into "good" and "bad" Catholics. In dark hours of persecution, they are either "true" or "false." Quantity decreases; quality increases. No crisis ever makes a person different from what he was; it only reveals his true character.

Take South Africa for example. The government upholds white supremacy, while the Church defends equality of all peoples. Because the Church, in accordance with reason and the Gospel, insisted on educating the blacks and allowing them to enter any Church they pleased, the government withdrew all support from religious schools. The Protestants turned over their schools to the State, the Church appealed for sacrifice.

Though there are only 150,000 Catholics in South Africa, they denied themselves to defend education for all. More than that, the crisis now made manifest the cross planted deep in the Catholic souls. One teacher with eleven children agreed to live on \$51 a month to assure the blacks of an education; another wrote to the Bishop "I shall keep on teaching for my Church and my religion even if I am paid nothing at all." Still another: "I shall remain. Christ suffered for us. We must be willing to suffer with Him and for Him."

If we had a persecution in the United States, Catholics would undoubtedly give more than 26¢ a piece to the Holy Father, not only for South Africa but for all the foreign missions. That is all they are giving now for the "Year of Christ." But why, in the name of the Crucified Savior, do we have to wait until the Communists take over before we really learn the meaning of sacrifice? Will you not begin now? Make a daily sacrifice. For example, deny yourself any tiny luxury. At the end of the month, send your sacrifices to the Holy Father through His Society of the Propagation of the Faith.

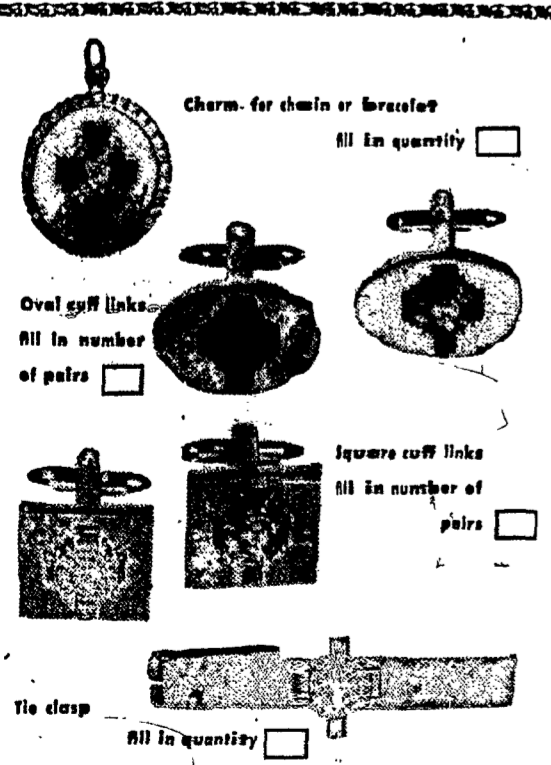
