The luncheon is sponsored by the Rochester Diocesan Council of Catholic Women. Mrs. Cyril Bishop with a gift and spiritual bouquet.

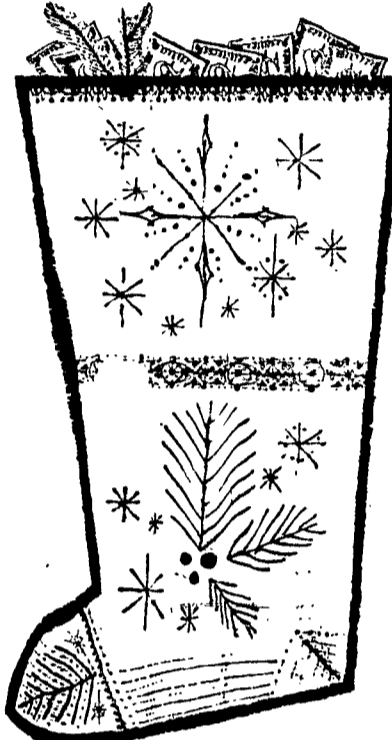

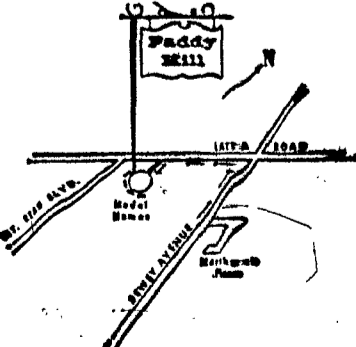
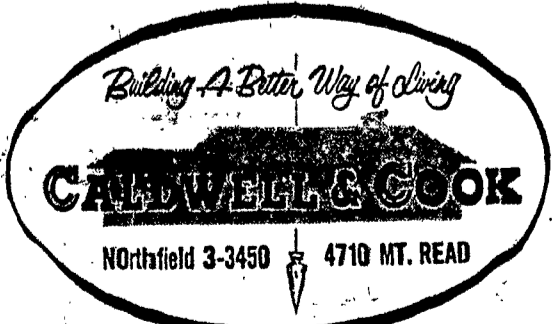
