Making Marriage Click
Love, Grace

"My marriage day by day is going from bad to horrible. What ever happened to all the graces I was to receive from the sacrament of Matrimony?" Heide.

One answer to your problem, Heide, could be in the very word "receive." A sacrament is not only a matter of "receiving" — it also involves giving. If you do not give, graces can be quite sterile.

There are three main areas in marriage when you give. This giving is not an overflow of the emotions, a vague belief in Catholic principles. It is the will to surrender to God's plan in a total way. God does not force us to cooperate, for then we would be "servants, not friends."

Remember that God wants our love, and the freedom to choose or reject Him is involved in love.

The expression, "man proposes and God disposes" can also be turned around, "God proposes and man disposes." Yes, man is definitely free. You ask, "How do marriage people cooperate with God?" It is certainly not by bizarre actions, unusual behavior, artificial airs of sanctity, and spiritual tensions.

There is cooperation with God in just plain everyday living. When a couple is in love, more and more and better and better they cooperate with God's plan. The more intimate couples are — spiritually, physically, emotionally — the holier they are. When a couple bring children into the world — care for them, teach them — that couple honors God. If there is friction and selfishness, there is no cooperation.

The spiritual level of a home may be judged by the intensity, delicacy, reverence, wholeness of marital intimacy. Love and graces are linked together from the very first moment of a marriage. This is the root: the more graces couples have the more love they should have, and the more love they have, the more graces they have.

Secondly, cooperation leads to a complete dedication. Cou-
