Midnight Mass To Herald Nativity Feast In Diocese

The Feast of the Nativity of Jesus, Saviour of the World and Prince of Peace will be fittingly ushered in at midnight with the celebration of Mass in all churches of the Diocese. Musical programs appropriate to the Feast and carols will be sung.

Auxiliary Bishop Casey will celebrate the Solemn Pontifical Mass in Sacred Heart Cathedral and will preach the sermon at the Midnight Mass.

Assisting the Bishop will be the Rt. Rev. Msgr. Wilfred Craugh, P.A. as Assisting Priest; Very Rev. Msgr. J. Emmett Murphy, Deacon; and the Rev. Mr. Thomas Green, S.J., Subdeacon. The Rev. Gerald J. Appleby will be master of ceremonies.

The music for the Mass starting with organ music by Cathedral organist Robert Allen, at 11:30 p.m., and singing of Christmas carols by the Girls' choir will be followed by the Girls' choir singing the Mass responses.

Doors of the Cathedral will open at 11 p.m. on Christmas Eve. Christmas Day Masses are listed at 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11-13 a.m. and 12-13 (noon).

Prior to the commencement of Mass, Mr. Harry Hanna, Organist and Choir Director will play Angels We Have Heard, Joy to the World and Silent Night.

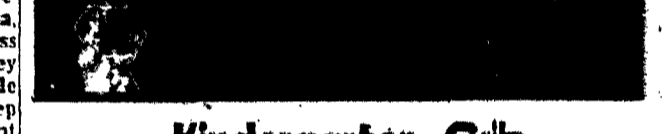
