Understanding, as defined by Webster, is "the intellectual power or the capacity . . . to form reasoned judgments". The art of listening and understanding is almost lost in our modern society.

**France Aid
To Schools
Given OK**

Paris — (RNS) — The French Senate passed by a vote of 173-59, the government's bill providing increased subsidies for Roman Catholic and other private schools.

"In the days of Al Smith, whispering and whispering among the often caricatured public discussions of religion and the Presidency," POAU declared. "Thus far in the pre-convention campaign, real issues have been discussed with reasonable calm and candor."

They praised Bishop Pike for his "serious and analytical reply" to the bishops' statement.

"When such controversial topics can be talked about publicly without charges and counter-charges of bigotry, it shows that we have progressed since 1928," said POAU.

In reviewing the events of 1959 in the field of Church-State relations, the organization of Lisbon's new subway project observed that "America lags in its being put into public becoming more mature in its service."

Although disagreeing with the statements issued by the Conference of Bishops on birth control, POAU cited it for "refreshing candor."

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
