#### To Be Printed

Sister Maria Lawrence, S.S.J., home economics teacher at Nazareth Academy, has been informed by the Home Economics Branch of the Education Division of Vocational Education in Washington, D.C., that a condensation of her thesis will be included in a research bulletin currently in process of publication.

Subject of the thesis, written as a requirement for a master's degree at Cornell University in 1958, is "Clothing inventories of 41 Teenage Girls." The study was undertaken to discover what selects and purchases teenage girls' clothing, how many clothes teenagers have—and how much individual items cost, and how much the complete outfit costs.

THE STUDY was made through questionnaires and inventory sheets filled out by Homemaking 2 Classes at Nazareth Academy in 1958. Results of the study show that young girls can profit from help in wardrobe planning.

Sister received her Bachelor of Science in Home Economics Degree at Marywood College, Scranton, Pennsylvania, and her Master of Science Degree at Cornell University.
