**Mrs. Murphy Requiem Held In Elmira**  
Mrs. Helen R. Murphy, 316 Walnut Street, Elmira died Jan. 28, 1960 at St. Joseph's Hospital where she had been a patient for about five months.  
Mrs. Murphy was the widow of Dr. Daniel P. Murphy, a prominent Elmira physician who died in 1920.  
A native Elmira, she was the daughter of the late John D. and Mary Alice Hubbard Ryan.  
In 1901, she married Dr. Murphy through whose efforts the Sisters of St. Joseph of Rochester opened St. Joseph's Hospital in 1908. Dr. Murphy was closely associated with the hospital from its establishment and contributed valuable assistance to its guidance.  
Mrs. Murphy attended Our Lady of Angels Academy, which was located on the site now occupied by the hospital. The modeled academy housed the original St. Joseph's Hospital.  
She was one of the oldest alumnae of the school.  
A Requiem Mass was offered on Monday morning at 10 a.m. at St. Patrick's Church. Rev. Francis J. Erk was celebrant.

**200 Attend Meet, Tea**
