

Repentance, Shrine For Nazi Victims

Hildestein — (RNS) — Plans for a Catholic "repentance church" to be built at Bergen, a small community near the notorious Nazi concentration camp of Bergen-Belsen in the Lueneburg Heath, were announced here by Bishop Heinrich Maria Jansen of Hildesheim.

The church will become a memorial shrine to the victims of the Hitler regime and especially to the 30,000 persons, mostly Jews, who were killed in the camp. The foundation stone will be laid on June 17, the day of the abortive 1953 uprising of East German workers against the Communist Soviet Zone regime.

One of the mass graves at the camp contains the remains of Anne Frank, the heroic Jewish girl whose diary written during the Nazi occupation of Holland in World War II achieved world-wide fame.

Student Loan Oath Said Inept Law

St. Louis University today issued a statement opposing the oath and affidavit provisions of the National Defense Education Act to provide loans for American college students, but said it would not withdraw from the program since this would constitute a denial for its students of free choice in the matter.

The University said that while the intent of the law was laudable, it was clear the law seeks to exclude from getting the benefits would be most likely to seek their ends by perjury and lies, thus making the law an inept instrument. The statement comments that "inept law is bad law."

The oath provision is unfair, the University contends, because students are required to swear their loyalty for common benefits of citizenship and law.

Rep. Kowalski has demanded personal household servants out of the Air Force not only of their own pockets.

Protestants Invited To Join Review Group

Chicago — (RNS) — Protestant church women were invited here to join the reviewing staff of the Catholic-sponsored National Office for Decent Literature.

Mgr. Thomas J. Fitzgerald, NODL executive secretary and executive director of the Catholic Women's Council of Publishers Union and paperback books easily accessible to youth. Comic books no longer represent a serious offense, he added, because that industry has adopted a system of self-regulation.

Cleveland — (RNS) — A doctor and lab technician perform heart tests on Benedictine Brother Blane Fergach at St. Andrew Abbey in Cleveland as part of a heart study program being conducted by the U.S. Department of Health. Some 2,000 Benedictines and Trappist monks throughout the country are taking part in the project in an investigation of the theory that fats in the diet may be related to hardening of the arteries and heart disease. The Trappist monks eat vegetables, fruits, grains, milk and milk products but no meat. The Benedictines, on the other hand, have a high-fat diet similar to that of the average American.

Jersey Priest Named To Clean Up Slums

Jersey City — (RNS) — A Catholic priest has been named by the City Commission here to head its \$1,000,000 drive against slum areas in Jersey City.

He is Msgr. Jerry E. McWilliams, pastor of St. Michael's church here, who will serve as director of the Revamped Jersey City Rehabilitation Bureau.

As unsalaried head of the bureau, Msgr. McWilliams will direct teams of city inspectors to enforce health, fire and building codes in housing. Violators must correct sub-standard conditions or face stiff fines.

The priest has been leading a committee of nine clergymen which has revitalized the city's flagging effort to arrest housing blight.

All clergymen in the city have been urged by the commission to report the address of any place where someone is making money on human misery."

Unity Asked In Uganda

Kampala — (RNS) — Church Missionary Society (Anglican) and Catholic authorities in Uganda's Northern Province jointly expressed concern here over growing divisions and dissensions among the population and urged both groups to join in fellowship with each other and put aside all hatred and bitterness, pointing out that the things on which they agree are far greater than those which divide them.

We are agreed that the cause of the divisions which exist between our people and in fact religious masters at all said a joint message read.

In churches in Acholi, Lango, West Nile and Karimoja, "They are political masters and some of them go back to the old rivalry between clan."

The message voiced particularly regret that some who claim to be followers of Christ are leaders in creating divisions and fostering hatred."

CHRISTIAN religion and Christian faith should not be identified with any one political party," the statement declared. All Christian men and women have duty to be interested in the affairs of their country and bring a moral influence to ensure that the political party to which they belong is Christian methods in further its aims." Slanders and stirring up of hatred against others, the Church leaders stated, should have no part in Christians' activities.


Nuns Purchase


